ITINERARY



Day 1: Arrival to El Salvador's San Romero International airport. Group is welcomed by ESNA's Alvaro and Guillermo. Settle in rooms. Orientation. Prepare for following day.

Day 2: Visit the Metropolitan Cathedral, the Magnificent Church of El Rosario, Cuscatlán Square and the UCA University.

Day 3: Visit the historical community of Izalco, an indigenous community in Sonsonate State, with a lot of history, including the infamous 1932 Peasant Massacre. Once there, we will meet with local leaders that will share their customs and history. Time to walk around the community of Izalco and enjoy the mesmerizing view of some of the largest volcanoes in the country! Head to Coatepeque Lake, which sits on top of an extinct volcano! Enjoy a delicious typical lunch. Time for swimming! Back to the Hotel.



Day 4: After breakfast, we will head to Cerro Verde National Park. After a short orientation regarding our surrounding, we will hike to the volcano of Santa Ana, the tallest volcano in the country, which seats at 7,818 feet.

It will be a 2 hour hike to the top with an amazing view to the Pacific Ocean, the Izalco Volcano, Sonsonate City and the Lake of Coatepeque. Once we make our way down from the Volcano, we will head for lunch. Then we will head back to the Hotel to rest.



DAY 5 - 7: Visit the community where we will be working for the next few days. Meet with community leaders and youth groups. Visit local School, people's home and hear what a typical day is like.
